

**Eatonbrook Lake Association
Virtual Meeting via Zoom
August 8, 2020 at 9 a.m.**

This meeting was held virtually via Zoom. Jim Cunningham generously coordinated and hosted the call.

The meeting was called to order by Colleen McSweeney, ELA President at 9:05. After explaining that the purpose of the meeting was to vote on whether or not to stock the lake with walleye fingerlings, she read the section of the bylaws describing membership guidelines and voting privileges.

A roll call was taken and approximately 40 members were present.

Tim Strand moved that the Association spend \$2,335 from the general fund to purchase walleye fingerlings. Judith Bailey seconded the motion.

Paul Mile-Matthias inquired as to what evidence there was so far that walleye have been effective in controlling milfoil. Colleen McSweeney referred to her e-mail sent on August 1. Jim Cunningham referred members to the study done by Paul Lord that is on the Association's website.

Ben Rogge suggested the Association look at other vehicles to validate that what we are doing is working and to consider using resources to look at other invasive species, such as water chestnuts.

There was a call for a vote and a second. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made to adjourn by Donna Isbell, and seconded by Chris Coulter, to adjourn at 9:35 a.m.
