Dear ELA Member,

Your board members have been looking into the cost of stocking the lake with Walleye fingerlings again this year. However, before the board can take action on this issue, we need you, lake association members, to vote on stocking the lake with fish, specifically Walleye, and how much of an expenditure ELA members are willing to commit to.

At our August 24, 2019 ELA meeting there was a unanimous vote to stock the lake with Walleye fingerlings, and that year we spent \$6,000 on Walleye fingerlings. In 2018 we spent \$7,500, and in 2017 we spent \$8,000 on stocking fish.

As of today, we have collected \$2,715 in fish donations since our payment to Hinkley's for last year's fingerlings. And, we have a balance of \$15,356.53 in our checkbook. (Please see attached Treasurer's Report from Amy Coulter).

On **Saturday August 8, 2020** at 9 AM we will hold a Zoom meeting to enable ELA members to take a vote on the issue of stocking the lake with Walleye including the amount that members want to spend on fish. We will vote in the usual way, only from a ZOOM meeting instead of in-person at the firehouse. This meeting is intended only for a vote on the fish.

Jim Cunningham will host the Zoom meeting. Instructions on how to join a meeting on Zoom are attached. Watch your e-mail for specific log in details.
